Self Help Skills

In order to promote independence, we will be encouraging the children to take off and put on their own coats, shoes and jumpers. We would really appreciate it if you could work on these skills at home.



Snack & Dinner

We provide a varied and healthy snack daily for your child. During snack time the children are encouraged to try different foods alongside developing their independence and social skills. To cover the cost of snack, other cooking activities and various nursery celebrations, we charge £1 per day. If you choose to send your child to school dinners the charge is an additional £2.50 per day. We would appreciate if you could post your child's snack and dinner money every Monday morning in a labelled envelope into the post box provided. You can choose to send your child to school dinners or provide them with a lunch. School dinners will begin on Monday 5th October and you will receive a copy of the school dinner menu monthly. If you choose to send your child to dinners then the combined total payable each week is £17.50.



Labels & Spare Clothes

Please ensure that your child's belongings are all labelled, that's everything from jumpers to hats and even shoes! It really helps us to keep track of your child's belongings and saves a lot of time and confusion! ©

Please leave a bag of spare clothes on your child's coat hanger. This is to ensure that we have dry items to change your child in the event of an accident e.g. a toileting or a messy play accident. We ask that you include pants, socks, trousers, t-shirt and a vest. A uniform is not necessary as your child may never need the spare items and good clothing will go to waste.

Please remember that shoes <u>must</u> have Velcro fastenings.
